The meeting was called to order by Chairman Watt at 8:30 a.m.

R. Musson gave an overview and presentation of the GIS system. New ortho photos will be provided through a grant with CRCOG in the spring of 2010 (fly over was done in April 2009). Applied Geographics does the mapping updates for us as we do not have the software (\$12,000) or staffing.

R. Musson displayed different layers of the software showing property boundaries, wetlands, topography etc. and explained that additional layers can be added at a cost of \$3,000 to \$5,000 per layer. W. Moorcroft suggested that some of this work may be able to be done by a college intern.


J. Soderberg discussed with the Selectmen the report he had prepared regarding discontinuance/abandonment of Town roads. Some of these roads were discussed in detail and viewed on the GIS.

It was agreed that further research and review should be conducted, that each of the suggested roads should be looked at individually and considered. The Selectmen requested that a committee be established with John Soderberg, Mike O'Leary, and representatives from PZC, Conservation and Land Acquisition, to come back to the BOS with recommendations. The Selectmen requested this work be completed by the end of August so the current Board could finish this project. Will Moorcroft and Brian O'Connell volunteered to head up this committee. The Board thanked John Soderberg for all his work in compiling this information.

It was agreed that written definitions of the words "abandonment", "discontinue" and "closed" be received from the Town Attorney.

M. Stuart moved to adjourn the meeting at 10:16 a.m. The motion passed unanimously.
