Approval of Minutes:

Public Hearing -The word “about” was eliminated from the last line of the first paragraph. Under **Wetland #4**, the word “he” is inserted in the first line after the word “narrow” and Ianni is added after John in the last sentence of **Wetland #4**. The line before Public Comment should read: They didn’t revise the plan; J. Soderberg said Wetlands should get a recommendation to the Planning & Zoning Commission. The word “the” was eliminated from the last line of the 2nd to the last paragraph.

M. Harder motioned to approve the November 18, 2010 Public Hearing minutes as amended, T. Loto seconded, T. Nofer and R. Warner abstaining, all were in favor.

New Applications:

Petition 10-25, 215 Kinney Road, Mark & Ann Baribault – Request for Farm Exemption under Section 4.1a of the Town of Hebron Inland Wetland Regulations to construct a Farm Pond

R. Warner motioned to grant “as of right” status under Section 4.1a of the Hebron Inland Wetland regulations, T. Nofer seconded, all in favor.

Petition 10-26, Hebron Lions Agricultural Society – Enhance and enlarge farm ponds for fire protection and irrigation (**Received 12-9-10 – 65 days - 2-11-11**)

Violation 08-18V – Patti Matthews, 108 Jan Drive, Hebron – Excavation of soils within a wetland

J. Soderberg got a call from Atty. Holtman, but nothing has been done by Patti Matthews.

Violation 10-03V, Camp Connecticut, 551 Old Colchester Rd. –clear cut, drainage ditches, and excavation of soils within a regulated area

Camp Connecticut wants to meet with J. Soderberg to go over what needs to be done again.

Violation 2010-18V, David & Monica Burr, 32 London Rd., Hebron – Filling of wetlands within a Conservation Easement

J. Ianni says nothing will be done until spring.

Other Pertinent Business:

Petition 04-12, Loveland Farms, LLC – Extension of Wetland Permit to 12-8-11

R. Warner motioned to extend the Wetland Permit until the end of December 2011, M. Harder seconded, all in favor.

Discontinuance and Abandonment of Certain Roads - short discussion

Election of Officers – There are 3 positions open; Chairman, Secretary and Vice Chairman. The Commission agreed that T. Loto be elected Chairman, R. Warner be re-elected Secretary and M. Harder be elected as Vice-Chairman.

R. Warner motioned, T. Nofer seconded, all in favor.

Review of Bylaws – 10.2, first sentence, after the word “within” was changed to thirty five (35) days. A sentence was added immediately after that sentence, which reads: Applicant can consent to extend time frame for any of the steps, but the total of all extensions together cannot exceed sixty five (65) days.

Approval of 2011 Meeting Schedule – The April meeting date was changed from April 7 to April 14.
