L.Preston called the meeting of the EDC to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Approval of Minutes:**

V.Avelis moved to approve the June 22, 2009 minutes as presented. J.Lesisko seconded the motion and it carried.

**Resignation of Chairman/ Discussion of EDC Officers**

It was noted that N.Dorval has resigned from the EDC. A letter was sent to the BOS dated August 20, 2009 indicating this resignation.

L.Preston moved to elect V.Avelis to act as Chairman of the EDC until January 2010 when the EDC election of officers will take place. J.Lesisko seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

V.Avelis moved to elect J.Lesisko to serve as secretary. L.Preston seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

**EDC Goals & Objectives**

M.O'Leary reported briefly on the history between the bonding company and the Town regarding the Village Green traffic light. He noted that he and Jim Celio had the opportunity to meet with the new Executive Director of the State Traffic Commission. Their discussion included developing phases for this project. The Town has re-applied as well as modified the permit and bond for the traffic light. Discussion ensued.

V.Avelis gave a brief update from the Horton Properties / Village Green Negotiation Committee that the BOS has put together. A proposed ordinance is in place. The format is to schedule a Public Hearing on the ordinance and the adoption of the ordinance will go to a Town Meeting for approval.

It was determined to go before the BOS and inform them as to what the committee has done and what it recommends. They will try to get on the October 1, 2009 BOS agenda.

**Survey of Business Community**

V.Avelis reported that she is currently working on a list of all business owners in Town. She stated she has come across a small group who is working on establishing a Town telephone book. Their efforts may be combined.

J.Lesisko advised to check with the Town of Glastonbury to inquire about the Glastonbury Service Club that has put together a community telephone book.


After some discussion it was determined that the list of business owners that V.Avelis has compiled will be divided between the EDC members. V.Avelis will check into the Survey Monkey website.
