1 CALL TO ORDER

D. Watson called the Regular Meeting of the Hebron Historic Properties Commission to order at 7:00pm at the Russell Mercier Senior Center. Regular members present at the Call to Order are D. Watson, L. Bordick and M.A. Foote. D. Watson then stated that the meeting would be moved to the Douglas Library. A notice was placed on the door of the senior center indicating that the meeting was moved to the library.

D. Watson seated S. Morin for R. Cassata.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – April 14, 2010 and May 5, 2010

No changes to the minutes were presented.

Motion:

L. Bordick moved to approve the April 14, 2010, Regular Meeting minutes and the May 5, 2010, Special Meeting minutes as presented. S. Morin seconded and the motion passed unanimously (4-0-0).

3. OLD BUSINESS

a. OBSERVATION POST

L. Bordick stated that her husband, Andy Bordick, would present the HHPC's recommendation regarding the Observation Post to the American Legion and VFW in the near future.

D. McCalla entered the meeting at 7:15pm.

Members agreed that the presentation to the Town does not need to wait until after the presentations to the American Legion and VFW. Members discussed some changes to the grid which will be submitted to the Town and noted which items in the budget will be left for the Town to determine.

Members discussed when to present the recommendation to the Pastor of the Church and decided it best to wait until the BOS has rendered their decision.

It was agreed that D. Watson would present the recommendation to Town Manager, B. Therrin, during the same meeting she discusses the location of the Preserve America sign.

D. McCalla briefly discussed the Eagle Scout project associated with the Observation Post.

b. CURRENT RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

M.A. Foote and L. Bordick discussed the current format of the research on the three (3) properties identified for local designation. D. Watson was charged with calling the State and obtaining a list of dates when they will meet and circulating those dates to the members so that the applications can be finalized in a timely manner. In addition, D. Watson was asked to inquire of B. Therrin when the HHPC could get the local designation matters onto the BOS Agenda.

M.A. Foote noted that the maps for 80 Hardy need to be completed.

c. PRESERVE AMERICA

Members discussed possible locations of the sign including:

1. On Route 66, coming into Town from Marlborough at the crest of the hill;
2. in front of the Town Office Building; and,
3. on Gilead Street near the Old Town Records Building.

D. Watson stated that she would contact B. Therrin and set up a meeting to discuss. Members also discussed that at some point in the future, additional grant monies may be available to purchase additional signs.

D. McCalla stated that she would take care of the publicity for the placement of the sign.

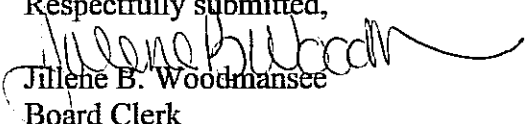
