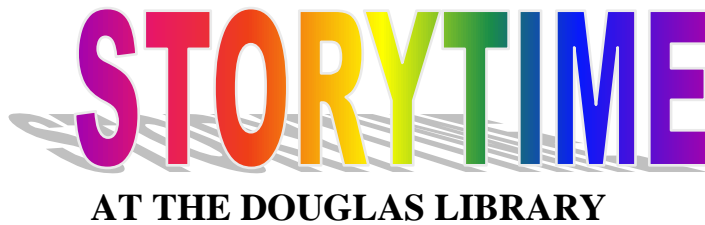

The Douglas Library Children’s Department will begin its next Storytime the week of January 10, 11 and 12. Registration is required for each six-week session and a waiting list is provided if space is unavailable. Registration forms will be available at the circulation desk in Children’s Dept.

Tuesday	10 AM	For 2 and 3 year olds
Wednesday	1 PM	For 4 and 5 year olds
Thursday	10 AM	For 0 to 2 year olds (Baby & Me)

A parent, grandparent or caregiver must accompany two and three year olds in program room during class. Four and five year olds may attend “on their own” if behavior is not an issue and an adult is on the floor. Parent or caregiver must be available for craft portion of the program. Crafts are prepared for the number of children registered to attend each session, we are sorry but we cannot accommodate drop-ins. Stories, crafts and other activities will be age appropriate.

We understand that Storytime is a first exposure to a group activity for many children. If your child needs a break, please feel free to walk around outside the program room and then rejoin us. Please try to be considerate of the other parents and children attending.

We ask parents to please not bring in sippy cups or snack foods. Bottles are the only exception for infants. Cell phone use is limited to the main lobby on the ground level; please turn off cell phones during Storytime. Strollers are allowed, but please keep aisles clear for other patrons.

Registration forms will be available to the public at the Children's Department circulation desk two weeks before the start of each new session.
