PARKS & RECEPTION

Parks

We have begun preparation of downtown landscaping and top dressing of the softball field at Veterans Park, in addition to general mowing around town.

The Skate Park has re-opened with posting of the rules. There is no charge.

Recreation

PREP theme for September is Entertainment month. The children are following a monthly calendar with games, arts and crafts projects and other activities while at the program. Most of the fall programs will start in September.

The AHM Teen Center is open Monday through Thursday from 2:30pm-6:00pm. The Teen Center will be closed Labor Day. Upcoming specials include origami, Flag Football, Cooking and Crayon Art.

The library's Saturday hours 10-3 will resume after Labor Day on September 8th. Attached is the Fall Children's story time schedule.

TOWN CLERK

I presented the Interim Town manager with a request to apply for a grant through the CT State Library to support a \$5,500 Preservation project. The total cost of the project is \$5,500; the grant award will be \$4,000 and the balance of \$1,500 will come from the Town Clerk's preservation line account. This request for permission to apply will be presented to the Board of Selectmen at their next regular meeting.

If awarded, the grant will support the completion of another phase in a long term plan to make the Hebron Land Records available electronically in the Town Clerks office as well as through a portal provided by www.uslandrecords.com and our land record vendor.

Currently, the entire land record indices (1698 – 2012) are available electronically for free. Images of the land records are available from July 1977 to the present day for a fee. This phase of the project will add an additional 30 years of searchable land records to the existing data base.

Researchers and appraisers can access these records through this portal and have the ability to purchase and print copies from their desk top computers. There are fees involved creating a small revenue stream for the Town. During the first seven months of this year, the Town received a little over \$1,000 as a direct result of creating public access through this link.

PUBLIC WORKS

We are roadside mowing various areas of the town and continue with work orders as they are called in. We are also paving various areas of Laura Drive, Hickory Drive and Meeting House Road. Residents should drive with caution in these work areas. Two of our employees, Darren Norton and Frank Gazdzicki, have attended the CT Transportation Institute Public Works Academy, their graduation will be held on October 25, 2012. Congratulations to both of them!

SENIOR CENTER

On Wednesday, August 29th Senator Prague provided a legislative update at the Senior Center. Her attendance also provided an opportunity for the seniors to extend their thanks to her for her years of advocacy for Connecticut's older adults and to wish her well in her future endeavors.

There will be a longer break in consideration of the holiday season. Classes resume in January 2013

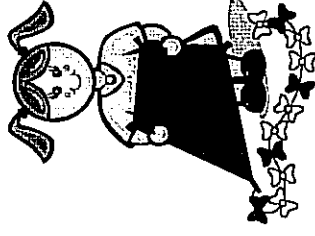
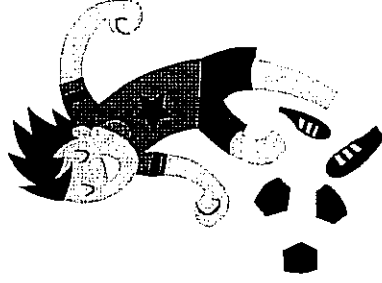

****PLEASE NOTE****

If Storytime is cancelled for any reason including
holidays or inclement weather, no make-up classes are
scheduled.

Each session of Storytime will run for 6 weeks, with a 2 wk.
break in between. Storytime will include stories, songs
finger plays, and a craft that is age appropriate. Parents are
encouraged to participate. Baby & Me has a very simple craft/
coloring activity.

Pre-registration will occur prior to each session.

Space is limited to 20 children per class, with a waiting
list that will give preference to those on it for the next
session. Registration forms will be available in the
Children's Department prior to each session. Phone
registrations will not be accepted. Registration is on a first
come first served basis. This program is open to the general
public. Our Storytime is not open to daycare providers.

Parents are included in the Baby & Me program, 2 and 3 year old
children should be accompanied by an adult, and 4 and 5 year olds
may be on their own in the Program Room during Storytime,
however, parent or caregivers must remain in Children's Dept. and
be available to assist your child during the craft portion of the
program.

Siblings or a visiting guest are welcome to attend Storytime
with enrolled child and an adult, as long as space is available
and behavior is appropriate. This may not include the craft
portion of the program unless there are absentees.

Carriages are not permitted in the Program Room due to fire
code. Please park them outside in main library area out of the
flow of traffic. As always, no food or drink is allowed in the
library. Please turn off cell phones. Changing tables are
located in the girl's lavatory and on the 1st floor in both the
men's and ladies rooms. Please do not leave soiled diapers in the
lavatory.
