DEPARTMENT NEWS:

PUBLIC WORKS

This week the Public Works Department finished up the main sweeping operation for the spring. In the upcoming weeks we will periodically clean up areas affected by storm washouts as needed. Roadside mowing is now a main priority and will be conducted daily. The curbing crew has completed repairs this week and the backfill process is starting. In addition we are repairing lawns from the plowing operations. Lastly, we started the preliminary work for the drainage project at Amston Lake. Preparations such as tree clearing and engineering took place to ready the jobsite for a Monday start.
